## BRADDON ROAD ALLOTMENTS GENERAL RISK ASSESSMENT

On behalf of Woodley Allotment Association, the following general risk assessment has been compiled by Carl Cleaver whom is a qualified Health and Safety Professional and also a plot holder of the Braddon Road Allotments.

The assessment has been kept brief but concise and it is believed correctly captures the applicable significant hazards and risks presented by the typical allotment environment under normal everyday conditions.

The assessment in essence is broken into three main 'sections':

- Section 1, captures and highlights the evident hazards and their associated risks and gives them an overall 'initial score' in respect of their potential severity and the likelihood of their occurrence before any 'control measures' are put into place.
- Section 2, highlights and explains suggested control measures to implement and follow to reduce and minimise the hazards identified and the potential risk and outcome which they pose.
- Section 3, details the same hazards and their potential risks and outcomes but gives a 'secondary score' demonstrating that if the suggested control measures are implemented how the hazard and overall 'risk rating' is reduced and as such creating a safer environment for all plot holders, their families and friends, visitors to the site and also local residents and the environment.

It is hoped that you find the assessment clear and easy to understand and agree with the hazards identified, but however if you have any confusion or need clarity or indeed note a significant hazard that has been missed, please inform a member of the committee.
